PHILIPPINE LIVESTOCK, FEED & MEAT MARKETS - POSITIVE OUTLOOK

With one of the youngest (65% below 30 years old) and the fastest growing populations in the world (Annual Growth Rate of 2.04%, 2010 census) the population of the Philippines is expected to hit 100 million people in 2014. Combined with an improving macroeconomic outlook, a growing middle class, and a transforming food retail sector, the outlook for the Philippine livestock, feedmilling and meat industries remains positive.

✓ In 2013 the Livestock and Poultry sub-sectors out-performed the overall Philippine Agriculture Market in terms of Production Value, registering and increase of 1.75% and 4.20%, respectively. Livestock accounts for 16.2%, while Poultry follows at 14.8% of the total Agricultural Production. The Fisheries sub-sector which recovered from 2012's (-0.25%) setback, registered an increase of 1.25% in 2013. Fisheries sub-sector contributes 18.0% of total agricultural output.




Feeds Expo Philippines 2015 Industry Awards

- ✓ Business Monitor International in their Philippines Agribusiness Report Q1 2014 believes that the livestock sector will continue to post healthy growth rates. BMI forecasts pork production growth to 2016/17 to increase 13.3% to 1.5million tonnes. Growth will be driven by an increase in commercial farming, as well as rising domestic consumption.
- ✓ The Philippine Government has passed the Agriculture and Fisheries Modernization Act (AFMA), aimed at strengthening the agriculture and fishery sectors. One of the main development goals is to transform the local livestock industry from a resource-based to technology-based industry; and enhance the market competitiveness of the local livestock and poultry sub-sector.
- ✓ The Philippines maintains its status as being free from Avian Influenza and Foot-and-Mouth Disease – enhancing the country's export capability.
- ✓ Tarlac, Batangas, Pangasinan and Ilocos Sur provinces have signed agreements with the Department of Agriculture to have double-A and triple-A slaughterhouses built to process meat for local and international markets, which is expected to reduce the need for imported meat.
- √ The country's meat consumption is predicted to reach three million tons in 2015.
- ✓ The Philippines continues to explore possibilities of expanding the exportation of processed meat and meat products to the United Arab Emirates, Brunei, Indonesia and Malaysia, all of which require Halal Certification.
- ✓ Increasing demand for animal protein, as a result of continued growth of the Philippine economy (GDP grew by 6.7% in 2013), has enhanced demand for animal and aquaculture feeds.


